

# JC Schools 2020 Summer School



## Enrolling **Non-Public** Kindergarten/Elementary/Middle School Students

### Who may enroll?

**Kindergarten, Elementary and Middle School students** who have residence within JC Schools boundaries and who desire to attend JC Schools summer school. There is no school recommendation required for students to attend summer school.

### Where/When to enroll?

#### **Kindergarten (those attending Kindergarten in 20-21 school year) AND 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade (current K – 7<sup>th</sup> grade)**

- After submitting the online application, you will receive an email with further instructions.
  - **Kindergarten (those attending Kindergarten in 20-21 school year)** – Parent/Legal Guardian will need to make an appointment with the JC Schools Welcome Center to bring in the required documents (see below). Email will contain a link to schedule an appointment.
  - **1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade (current K – 7<sup>th</sup> grade)** – Parent/Legal Guardian does not need to show up in person at JC Schools Welcome Center as long as proof of residency is provided another way (see below).
- In order to maintain optimal class sizes, JC Schools will be limiting summer school enrollments within each grade and school. To ensure that your student will attend summer school in the school building in whose boundary you reside and be eligible for district provided transportation, we recommend completing online registration (OLR) **before April 21<sup>st</sup>**. For OLR applications received after classrooms within your boundary school/grade reach capacity, district officials may assign the student to a classroom in another school building that has availability. District provided transportation will not be available in this situation. Placement in school buildings outside of your boundary school is strictly based on enrollment numbers and is not available for parent request.

**9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade (current 8<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> grade)** – Online registration applications will not be accepted until 4/27/20. Do NOT include high school students in your online application with elementary and/or middle school siblings.

### What is required?

- Proofs of residency may be uploaded to the online enrollment application, faxed to 573-659-3028, emailed to [welcomecenter@jcschools.us](mailto:welcomecenter@jcschools.us), or brought in person to the Welcome Center. If faxing or emailing, please include the name of the student.
- A list of acceptable proof of residency documents is attached.
- Proofs of residency must include a date within the last 45 days along with the parent's name and address.
