

During the winter months it may become necessary to alter school bus routes when road conditions become hazardous because of snow or ice. Roads with potentially dangerous conditions will be avoided. Alternate stops have been established along these routes for students to meet their bus and in some areas it may be a necessity for parents to take their children to these points. Changes are made for the safety of all students concerned. Drivers must continue to use their good judgment in deciding if a road or street may be safely traveled.

Route 1

- Bus will not travel past Randall on Scotts Station Rd. Students should meet the bus at the corner of Scotts Station Rd and Randall at 8:15 am.
- Bus will not travel past Kevin on Randall. Bus will not travel Joseph, Vickie, or Kevin. Students should meet the bus at the corner of Kevin & Randall at 8:20 am. Bus will turn around at Kevin and Randall.

Route 2

- Bus will not travel Mall Ridge, Kent, or Amador. Students should meet their bus at the intersection of Scott Station and Mall Ridge at 8:24 am.

Route 3

- Bus will not travel Bello Paseo or Vista Campo. Students should meet their bus at the intersection of Bonita Paseo and Vista Campo at 8:02 am.
- Bus will not travel Dean Dr, Kaylyn Dr, Don Ray or Sue Dr. Students should meet bus at either
 - Sue Dr & Hwy 179 at 8:15 am or
 - Sue Dr & Schumate Chapel at 8:25
- Bus will not travel Shawn Dr, or Troy Dr. Students should meet the bus at Schumate Chapel & Shawn at 8:30 am.
- Bus will not travel Schumate Chapel Road beyond Schumate Chapel Trailer Park. Students should meet their bus at the entrance to Schumate Chapel Trailer Park at 8:30 am.

Route 76

- Bus will not travel Huntleigh Place. Students should meet bus Schellridge Rd & S Country Club at 8:15
- Bus will not travel Terra Bella or Del Ray. Bus will turn around at Ventura and Struempfh.
