

During the winter months it may become necessary to alter school bus routes when road conditions become hazardous because of snow or ice. Roads with potentially dangerous conditions will be avoided. Alternate stops have been established along these routes for students to meet their bus and in some areas it may be a necessity for parents to take their children to these points. Changes are made for the safety of all students concerned. Drivers must continue to use their good judgment in deciding if a road or street may be safely traveled.

Route 209

- Bus will not travel Co Rd 486 or Tebbetts View Dr. Students should meet their bus at the store in Tebbetts at 6:35 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rd 4023 or 4020. Students should meet their bus at 4021 and 4023 at 6:45 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rd 4024 or 4025. Students should meet their bus at State Hwy AA & Co Rd 4021 at 6:50 am.
- Students living between Co Rd 4006 and 4021 off of AA will be picked up approximately 6:55 and 7:00 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rd 488. Students should meet their bus at Co Rd 488 and AA at 7:05 am.

Route 204

- Bus will not travel 4031 past Big Sky. Students who live past Big Sky will need to meet their bus at the intersection of 4031 and Big Sky at 6:50 am.

Route 201

- Bus will not travel Rt BB or Co Rd 480. Students should meet bus at Rt AA & Rt BB at 6:40 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rd 4006. Students should meet their bus at the intersection of Co Rd 4006 and St Rd AA at 6:50 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rds 4009, 4012, 4018, 4002, 488. Students must meet their bus at Co Rd 488 and AA at 7:00 am.

Route 203

- Bus will run this route as normally scheduled.
