

During the winter months it may become necessary to alter school bus routes when road conditions become hazardous because of snow or ice. Roads with potentially dangerous conditions will be avoided. Alternate stops have been established along these routes for students to meet their bus and in some areas, it may be a necessity for parents to take their children to these points. Changes are made for the safety of all students concerned. Drivers must continue to use their good judgment in deciding if a road or street may be safely traveled.

**Route 203**

- Bus will not travel 4031 past Big Sky. Students who live past Big Sky will need to meet their bus at the intersection of 4031 and Big Sky at 6:45 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rd 4023, 4020, 4024 and 4025. Students should meet their bus at 4021 and 4023 at 6:30 am.
- Bus will not travel E Simon Blvd. Students should meet their bus on at the corner of E Simon Blvd and Jefferson Rd at 7:00 am.

**Route 205**

- Students living between Co Rd 4006 and 4021 off of AA will be picked up approximately 6:40 am.
- Bus will not travel Rt BB or 486. Students should meet their bus at Rt AA & Rt BB at 6:35 am.
- Bus will not travel Co Rd 4009, 4012, 4018, 4002, 4006, 4004 or 488. Students must meet their bus at Co Rd 4006 and AA at 6:45 am.

**Route 209**

- Bus will not travel past Co Rd 4028 going South on 4031. Students South of 4028 should meet at the intersection of 4028 and 4031 at 6:45 am.
- Bus will not travel 4021. Students will meet their bus at the corner of Rt AA and 4021 at 6:34 am.
