During the winter months it may become necessary to alter school bus routes when road conditions become hazardous because of snow or ice. Roads with potentially dangerous conditions will be avoided. Alternate stops have been established along these routes for students to meet their bus and in some areas it may be a necessity for parents to take their children to these points. Changes are made for the safety of all students concerned. Drivers must continue to use their good judgment in deciding if a road or street may be safely traveled.

- Bus will not travel Creek Trail, Portabella or Notting Hill. Students must meet bus at Creek Trail & Edgewood Dr at 8:11 am.
- Bus will not travel Concord, Saratoga or Lexington Dr. Students should meet their bus at the corner of Rolling Hills Rd and Lexington at 8:27 am.
- Bus will not travel, Colonial Hills, Independence or Bunker Hill. Students must meet bus at Colonial Hills
 Veith at 8:25

Route 14

- Bus will not travel beyond Hemstreet Rd. on Route C. Students should meet the bus at the intersection of Route C and South Country Club at 8:10 am.
- Bus will not travel Zion Rd. Students will meet the bus at the intersection of Route C and South Country Club at 8:10 am.
- Bus will not travel Hohm Way or Moreau River Ln. Students will meet the bus at the intersection of Monticello Rd and Moreau Ridge Dr at 8:25 am.

Route 42

- Bus will not travel Renns Lake Rd. Students should meet their bus at the Intersection of Idlewood & Renns Lake Rd at 8:26 am.
- Bus will not travel Allison, Christine, Cheryl Dr, Courtyard, Meadowview or Lakeview. Students should meet their bus at the intersection of Idlewood and Allison, Idlewood and Cheryl or at the intersection of Idlewood and Courtyard at 8:20 am.
