- Bus will not travel the junction of Schott Rd. Students past this point should meet the bus at Shott Rd and E Mccarty St at 6:40 am.

#### Route 217

- Bus will not travel El Dorado, Nelson or Del Cerro Roads. Students should meet their bus at any of the following stop times.

  - Nelson and Bald Hill at 6:58 AM
  - El Dorado and Bald Hill at 6:56 AM
  - Del Cerro and Bald Hill at 7:02 AM.
