

During the next winter it may become necessary to alter school bus routes when road conditions become hazardous because of snow or ice. Roads with potentially dangerous conditions will be avoided. Alternate stops have been established along these routes for students to meet their bus and in some areas it may be a necessity for parents to take their children to these points. Changes are made for the safety of all students concerned. Drivers must continue to use their good judgment in deciding if a road or street may be safely traveled.

Route 8

- Bus will not travel Rustic and Dewberry. Students should meet their bus at the intersection of Greenbriar and Dewberry at 7:50am.
- Bus will not travel Shephard Hills. Students should meet their bus at Hwy 54 and Shepherd Hills at 7:55 am.

Route 15

- Bus will not travel Iven Rd or Camzie Dr. Students should meet the bus at the corner of Hoffman & Tanner Bridge at 8:00 am.
- Bus will not travel Tanner Bridge Rd south of Hwy 179. Students should meet bus at Tanner Bridge & Lorenzo Green at 7:50.
- Bus will not travel Millbrook or Weather Rock Rd between Lorenzo Green & Millbrook. Students should meet the bus at Lorenzo Green & Millbrook at 8:00 am.

Route 72

- Bus will not travel Strong Sub Division. Students should meet bus at Strong Sub Division & Southwood Hills at 7:50 am
- Bus will not travel Cedar Bluff & Southwood Terr. Students should meet their bus at Southwood Hills and Cedar Bluff at 8:00am.

Route 39

Bus will run route as normal.

The Jefferson City school district will provide the local radio stations with information on school closings or busses running snow routes as early as 5:30 am.
