**Route 213**

- Bus will not travel Rustic and Dewberry. Students should meet their bus at the intersection of Greenbriar and Dewberry at 6:30 am.
- Bus will not travel Shephard Hills. Students should meet their bus at Hwy 54 and Shepherd Hills at 6:45 am.
- Bus will not travel Strong Sub Division. Students should meet bus at top of Strong Sub Division & Southwood Hills at 6:55 am.
- Bus will not travel Cedar Bluff & Southwood Terr. Students should meet their bus at Southwood Hills and Cedar Bluff at 7:00am.

**Route 216**

- Bus will arrive at Broadmore Apartments at 6:35 am.
- Bus will arrive at Weathered Rock Apartments at 6:40 am.
- Bus will not travel Tanner Bridge south of Rt B/Lorenzo Green. Students should meet bus at Tanner Bridge & Lorenzo Green (on Tanner Bridge) at 6:45 am.
- Bus will not travel Hoffman Dr, Knight Valley Dr, Park Crest Dr, Iven Rd or Camzie Dr. Students should meet the bus at the corner of Hoffman & Tanner Bridge at 6:47 am.
