

## VIRTUAL EDUCATION RESOURCES

The <u>Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education</u> allows for students to be enrolled in **full-time** <u>Missouri Course Access and Virtual School Program (MOCAP)</u> programs. Families interested in moving to full-time virtual education must apply with one of the MOCAP approved providers listed below after enrolling with the Jefferson City School District. *Jefferson City School District will not approve MOCAP vendors without a host district*.

## \*\*\* IMPORTANT FOR FAMILIES \*\*\*

The following is very important information. It is NOT an all-inclusive list.

- Full-time virtual students are NO LONGER a student within JC Schools.
- Full-time virtual students will NO LONGER be able to participate in any JC School MSHSAA activity or extra-curricular activity
- For students with an IEP or 504, the virtual vendor or host district will be responsible for the development and implementation of these plans
- Any device needed (Garmins, Chromebooks, computers, etc) will not be provided by JC Schools. Some virtual providers supply these devices but others may not. Be sure to check with the virtual provider.
- Full-time virtual students returning to in-seat at JC Schools must go through the new student enrollment process
- It is the responsibility of the family/student to report change of address/residency to the host district and Jefferson City School District
