Enroll in the Program

Jefferson City School District (“JC Schools”) is partnering with **One2One Risk Solutions** to provide risk management administrative services for our student assigned technology. Please visit “www.one2onerisk.com” to enroll in the program. You will be prompted for the following information: State | School District | School | Student ID Number

Those that do not wish to enroll using the website may enroll during the night of Parent Orientation. Participation in the JC Schools insurance program is an important part of the learning experience. Those that do not enroll will not be able to take their district issued iPad/Chromebooks off school grounds for home use.

Agree to the Terms and Conditions

You will be responsible for protecting your assigned device from loss or damage. If an accident or loss should occur, JC Schools will waive your responsibility for the financial loss subject to a deductible as outlined below. In exchange for this damage waiver, JC Schools requires an annual fee of \$30.00 (\$15.00 for students in the free or reduced lunch program). For families with multiple children, there is a maximum annual fee of \$100 per family (\$50 for families in the free or reduced lunch program).

Make a Payment

Payment of the \$30.00 (or \$15.00 if applicable) damage waiver fee may be made with a debit card, major credit card, or ACH using your bank routing and account numbers. After payment is authorized, you will receive confirmation of your payment and you will be allowed to use the device at home.

Student Assigned Technology Deductible Structure

If a student has a covered claim, they must pay a deductible according to the table below. Students will not be allowed take their device home while there is an unpaid deductible on their account.

Incident	Deductible
1st Occurrence	\$25
2nd Occurrence	\$50
3rd and subsequent Occurrences	\$100

The deductible amount does not reset each year. However, for each year a student has no claims, the District will reduce the deductible amount by one step the following year. In addition, for students having no claims for a year or more, the district will waive payment of the deductible one time for each consecutive year without a claim. Example, if a student has no claims during the first year, then has two claims during the second year, the District will waive payment of the first occurrence deductible (\$25) but the student must pay the second occurrence deductible (\$50).

Excluded Losses:

Certain conditions not covered by this damage waiver include: 1) any dishonest, fraudulent, malicious or criminal acts, 2) any loss to software, data, documents, music, videos, recordings or other personal information that I have placed on the device, 3) additional loss caused by the failure to use all reasonable means to protect the device after it has been damaged, 4) disappearance of the device not reported to local law enforcement, and 5) any use not in accordance with District policies and procedures.
