Capital City High School is located in Jefferson City, Missouri and is part of the Jefferson City School District. JCSD serves an area of 223 square miles in parts of Cole and Callaway Counties. The district is home to an early childhood center, 11 elementary schools, two middle schools, two high schools, an alternative school, a career center, and an adult learning center. Jefferson City is the Capital of the state of Missouri, hence the name Capital City High School.

School Profile

Capital City High School was built in 2019 and is set to have its first graduating class this school year in the spring of 2022. CCHS serves a diverse population of over 1300 students including both urban and rural populations. The students are offered a wide variety of academic opportunities, including honors, dual enrollment (through Lincoln University), Advanced Placement, and Project-Lead-The-Way courses, as well as an A+ program. Additionally, CCHS provides a large number of extra-curricular activities and sports for its students.
