Boundary Line Changes - Family Scenarios -

In general, JCPS wants families to attend the school in their attendance area. However, JCPS does not want to split families when siblings could be together in the same building. We will grant special permission for the following boundary-related scenarios:

1. A student has an older sibling attending the requested building and both siblings will attend the school at the same time.
2. Current (2018-2019) TJMS or LCMS students can finish their middle and high school career with their class, provided residency does not change.
3. If you are currently attend Cedar Hill or Thorpe Gordon, or are a middle school student who attended Cedar Hill or Thorpe Gordon, and you live in the [area impacted by boundary line changes](#), you are eligible for special permission if you'd like to stay in your current building (with your current class).

If one of these scenarios applies to you or your family, you must submit a [Boundary Change Special Permission form](#) by Feb. 1, 2019. Only families affected by the boundary line changes are eligible to apply for special permission at this time. All non-boundary line special permission requests can be submitted when that window opens in April.

Thorpe Gordon Elementary Scenarios

I attend Thorpe Gordon and live in the area that currently goes to LCMS.

- You will attend LCMS and JCHS.

I attend Thorpe Gordon now (K-5th) and live in the area that currently goes to TJMS, but the boundary changes will place me at LCMS.

- See scenario #3 above.

Cedar Hill Elementary Scenarios

I attend Cedar Hill and live in the section not affected by the boundary changes.

- You will attend LCMS and JCHS.

I attend Cedar Hill now (K-5th) and live in the section that currently goes to LCMS, but the boundary changes will place me at TJMS.

- See scenario #3 above.

Lewis and Clark Middle School Scenarios

I currently attend LCMS and want to stay there.

- You will remain at LCMS. See scenarios #2 and #3 above.

I currently attend LCMS and want to go to TJMS.

- You are required to attend LCMS if you live in the LCMS attendance area.
- If you live in the section of the Cedar Hill attendance area that now goes to TJMS, see scenarios #2 and #3 above.

I'm an 8th grader at LCMS and want to attend JCHS next year.

- You will attend JCHS because it is in your attendance area.
- If you live in the section of the Cedar Hill attendance area that is now within the new TJMS/CCHS boundary, see scenarios #2 and #3 above.

I'm an 8th grader at LCMS and want to attend CCHS next year.

- If you live in the section of the Cedar Hill attendance area that is now within the new TJMS/CCHS boundary, see scenarios #2 and #3 above. Otherwise, there is no special permission for CCHS.

Thomas Jefferson Middle School Scenarios

I currently attend TJMS and want to stay there.

- You will remain at TJMS. See scenario #2 and #3 above.

I currently attend TJMS and want to go to LCMS.

- You will attend TJMS if you live in the TJMS attendance area.
- If you live in the section of the Thorpe Gordon attendance area that now goes to LCMS, see scenarios #2 and #3 above.

I'm an 8th grader at TJMS and want to attend JCHS next year.

- You will attend CCHS if you live in the CCHS attendance area.
- If you'll have a sibling at JCHS next year, or you live in the section of the Thorpe Gordon attendance area that now goes to LCMS/JCHS, see scenarios #1, #2 and #3 above.

Jefferson City High School Scenarios

I currently attend JCHS and want to remain at JCHS.

- All current 10th and 11th graders at JCHS will continue at JCHS through graduation.

I currently attend JCHS and want to go to CCHS.

- All current 10th and 11th graders at JCHS will continue at JCHS through graduation.

Capital City High School Scenarios

I currently attend TJMS and want to attend CCHS.

- You will attend CCHS because it is in your attendance area.
- If you live in the section of the Thorpe Gordon attendance area that now goes to LCMS/JCHS, see scenarios #2 and #3 above.

I currently attend LCMS and want to attend CCHS.

- You will attend JCHS if you live in the JCHS attendance area.
- If you live in the section of the Cedar Hill attendance area that now goes to TJMS/CCHS, see scenario #2 and #3 above.
