Dear Jefferson City Public Schools Parents,

Providing a safe and secure learning environment for your children is very important to all of us. We have numerous safety and security measures in place that we are always looking to enhance. Beginning this school year, we have expanded safety and security supports to our school community to now include the **Courage2Report Missouri**.

Students, parents and community members should use **Courage2Report Missouri** to confidentially report threats of violence, suicide, bullying and illegal activity that could harm children in our schools. (We encourage the personal relationship with the school administrators and that reporting through them is preferred). However, this service will provide users the opportunity to communicate confidentially with a live agent 24/7 and report any acts that could potentially cause harm to self or others. The hotline is administered by an independent, outside agency and ALL communications are PRIVATE and CONFIDENTIAL.

Your message will be communicated with school officials, all information will remain confidential to encourage the reporting of all safety and security concerns.
