Classroom teachers will communicate any needed additional information with families after summer school begins.


Library

Students will only be released from school, during the day, through the office. Parents/guardians should check their students out through the office. Students returning to school must also check in through the office.


EARLY MORNING DROP-OFF AND SUPERVISION:



Front doors open at 7:15. When dropping your child off for school in the morning, please do not exit your vehicle in the drop off lane, Please do not park in the drop off lane. Please stay behind the vehicle in front of you and pull out in single file order.

Students should stay in the vehicle until you have pulled up to the fire lane. Students should be ready to exit the vehicle from the curb side of the car. Give a "high five", "have a great day", and "I love you". If for any reason a student is not ready to exit the vehicle (missing backpack, missing lunchbox, car seat, etc...), please utilize the parking in the front or side of the building. If you plan to enter the building, please utilize parking in the front or side of the building. Following these procedures will ensure everyone is safe during morning drop off. Your cooperation is appreciated.

STUDENT PICK-UP PROCEDURES: For students that are picked up on a regular basis, parents will need to register with the office. Each family will receive a placard (car tag), which tells who you are picking up. Students will be picked up from the Gym door. Parents will stay in their vehicles and students will be brought out to you. Mrs. Ahart will have a placard ready on June 6th for anyone new to Callaway Hills. Placards will be with the student at dismissal.



If changes need to be made to a student's normal means of transportation, please call the office at 896-5051 by **2:45** pm so we can accommodate you. To help ensure a safe and responsible pick up procedure, students will not be released after **3:00** pm unless there is an emergency with the family.
