Snowman Relay Race

Teams race to see who can build the snowman the fastest. All you need is toilet paper, scarves and hats!



Penguin Race

Give students red and green balloons and have them race from one end of the room to the other with the balloon held between their knees. They'll look like they're waddling like a penguin! This would work well as a relay race where they pass the balloon to the next person on their team.

Construction Paper Garland
