What is Google Classroom?

- A tool used by teachers and students to share work electronically.
- Another form of communication between students and teachers.
- A tool used to give the same information to many students at once.
- Runs through the students' school email address.

Getting Started

Ask your child to share this information with you, or contact their teacher.




1 Open a Google Chrome browser.

2 Go to google.com and click sign in.



3 Type in your student's School Google Email address and password.



You should now be logged into your student's Gmail Account.




You can click on the 9 squares (aka "waffle") icon in the top right hand corner to see the Google Suite of Products.




Google Calendar
