<b>Reading Workshop Components</b>	<b>Teacher's Roles</b>	<b>Students' Roles</b>
Mini-Lesson	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Connect each lesson to ongoing student work.</li><li>• Teach a skill or strategy to help students as readers.</li><li>• Model thinking processes.</li><li>• Read a variety of texts aloud.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Be an active listener.</li><li>• Turn and talk, and stop to write thoughts down to hold on to or grow understanding.</li><li>• Participate in conversations.</li></ul>
Work Time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Confer with individual students.</li><li>• Meet with small groups.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Read independently.</li><li>• Solve problems independently.</li><li>• Grow thinking by writing.</li></ul>
Share	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Share the thoughts and work of individuals.</li><li>• Share the thoughts and work of small groups.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Share thoughts and work from the lessons.</li><li>• Listen to others' ideas and work.</li></ul>
