

REMEMBERING TREAZURE DUNN



With a sad heart we communicate that we recently lost a Bulldog. Treazure Dunn passed away recently. She attended Belair as a kindergartner last year. Please keep her family in your prayers. Treazure Mazel Dunn, age 6, passed away Thursday, November 16, 2023, at Cardinal Glennon's Children's Hospital in the arms of people who loved her, including her mommy, Diamon Dunn; her mommy, Chelsea Luck; and her nanny, Janel Luck.

She was born June 2, 2017, in St. Louis to Diamond Dunn of Columbia, Missouri. Treazure came into Chelsea's life in May 2021, and lived with her in Jefferson City, Missouri.

Treazure had many medical challenges in her short life but was spunky, sassy, fun-loving, and resilient through it all. She loved music and dancing and insisted on hearing Santa Claus is Coming to Town on repeat, yelling "watch out!" every time. She had favorites on Hits 1 and could often be heard singing along from her car seat, especially when "baby, no hurt me" came on. Treazure enjoyed adaptive skating and horseback riding lessons and the wonderful volunteers that helped her in those programs. She loved to have a beautiful hairstyle, even if she didn't love having her hair done. She had a firm belief that there was no such thing as too many bracelets and that a tutu was appropriate attire for any occasion.

Treazure was a proud Belair Bulldog and was in her element as a student in her kindergarten class. "Bus up me?" was a frequent question when she wondered if it was a school day. She also enjoyed her time at Southwest Early Childhood and her summer in daycare at the Special Learning Center, where her wheelchair and AFOs were just the norm and didn't make her different.

Treazure always rocked as a means of self-soothing, and although she liked the Treazure-sized rocker Nanny got for her, she would often ask to sit in the "big wocker" to watch TV. Her favorite shows included That Girl Lay Lay, Family Reunion, and Sister, Sister, although sometimes she was happy to just sit and watch "ball" with Bob.

Treasure especially loved spending time with her sisters whether for special occasions or just visits. She always had a picture of her and her sisters in her bedroom at home and in every hospital room.

Treazure is survived by her mom, Diamond Dunn; siblings, Chris'chiauna Dunn, Jordyn Dunn, and Adrian Wilkz Jr.; "Mommy 2", Chelsea Luck; grandparents, Janel and Bob Luck; aunts and uncles, Simmone Sutton, Jadaunte Sutton, Ciena Fair, Yanasha Fair, Christian Fair and Mekhi Fair; bonus aunt, Brianne Luck and the family pets, Lily, whom she loved dearly, Henrietta, whom she tolerated and Muna, whom she didn't care for much.

She was preceded in death by her grandmother, Vanessa Sutton-Fair and brothers, Noel Young and Khalil Davis.


